Vary what we do Do some fun activities – not all coursework/textbook Are honest with us Work independently but get help when we need it Choose where we sit Stay calm and patient Mark our books on time Help us understand our mistakes Show your passion for your subject Use video, audio or online resources Know us as individuals and listen to us Use the starter to recap the lesson before Control the class – strict, but not too strict Give us time to practice what we've learned Are fair, consistent and don't have favourites Are happy and show that you enjoy teaching us Work answers through with us if we don't know Pitch the lesson right - not too hard, not too easy Talk to us on a level - don't talk down or condescend Tell us how to revise instead of leaving us to experiment

Make sure the whole class is engaged so there are no distractions

Recall knowledge through guizzes and mini-tests Make sure we understand before we move on Stay organised and keep our notes in order Take responsibility for our own learning Are involved in what we're learning Help each other when we're stuck Take the right subjects in options Are not afraid to ask a question Practice what we've learned Treat everyone with respect Do practice exam questions Enjoy what we're learning Have a good night's rest Learn at the right pace Take on challenges Have a clear goal Explain things well and show how theory is applied in practice Listen carefully Understand the big picture – we are taking other subjects too! Stau focused Reward us for doing well and make us feel good about ourselves **Attend**
